




The booklet presents information about KAZTEST system - Kazakh language proficiency level assessment of the citizens of the Republic of Kazakhstan.

WHAT IS KAZTEST?

KAZTEST is a local system of assessing the level of Kazakh language knowledge of citizens of Republic of Kazakhstan and foreigners who conduct their activities in the territory of Kazakhstan.

CONTENT STRUCTURE OF THE KAZTEST SYSTEM

LISTENING SECTION

(dialogue, monologue, polylogue)

- cultural and social dialogues;
- narrative text;
- adapted interview from mass media.

B1, B2, C1

- · materials from the mass media;
- dialogues from a social-cultural field;
- · dialogues from an official field;
- dialogues are in an officially business sphere;
- · sampels of document control materials;
- samples from a scientific political field.

LEXIS-GRAMMATICAL STRUCTURE

The tasks consist phonetics, morphology, lexis and grammar of Kazakh.

Test item rubrics are given in simple words that is clear to all:

- Address pronoun (words that are used to attract the attention of somebody to someone);
- homonym (find the word that is written and read the same, but with different meanings);
- · synonym (find the word with similar meaning);
- antonym (find the words with opposite meanings);

- Joint words (indicate the words that are formed by joining two words);
- present simple (find the action that occurs in the present time);
- past simple (find the action that occurred in the past);
- future simple (find the action that will occur in the future).

CONTENT STRUCTURE OF THE KAZTEST SYSTEM

READING SECTION

(expository, narrative, argumentative)

Texts are taken from the newspapers, the magazines, the textbooks and the fictions.



B2	expository, narrative and argumentative and adapted mixed text with elements of affective evaluation	250-300 words (summary)	texts from social-cultural and official fields
Cl	situational texts	Writing an essay that consists 300-350 words	texts from social-cultural, scientific, official and academic fields that are important in everyday relationships

TESTING DURATION

In the KAZTEST system, it is necessary to answer 150 test tasks on Listening, Reading and Lexical-grammatical structure. The test items are in the formaty multiple choice questions, with one correct answer.

Duration is 150 minutes or 2 hours, 30 minutes.







I stage – Diagnostic testing






NATIONAL STANDARDS OF THE REPUBLIC OF KAZAKHSTAN



State standards ST RK 1926-2009, ST RK 1928-2009, ST RK 1927-2009, ST RK 1925-2009, ST RK 1929-2009 are unique Acts regulating the process of teaching Kazakh language and the procedure of assessing Kazakh language knowledge level. In 2014 alterations and additions were made to these standards. Since State standards are acting as National standards of teaching and assessing Kazakh language knowledge level being confirmed in the order №236-од of chairmen of Committee of technical regulations and meteorology of the

Ministry of investigations and development of Republic of Kazakhstan on 24 November of 2015 (ST RK 1926-2015, ST RK 1928-2015, ST RK 1928-2015, ST RK 1928-2015).

In National standards there is a list of professions, specialties and occupations for whom the state language is recommended to know in sufficient level according to their qualification requirements. This Act can answer to a number of questions among Kazakhstani community such as «Who should know state language? What are their recommended levels?». National standards are implemented from 1st of January of 2017.

METHODS OF TEACHING KAZAKH AS A SECOND AND FOREIGN LANGUAGE









STANDARD PROGRAM OF TEACHING KAZAKH LANGUAGE

Standard program of teaching Kazakh as a second and foreign language for adults is a first program issued within the frame of State program of development and use of languages in the Republic of Kazakhstan for 2011-2020. It is a unique instrument of systematizing the process and methods of teaching Kazakh. Standard program was published in 2012, and will be adjusted and amended during 5 years of establishing the practice. Second edition was published in 2016. Standard program is based in the methodology supporting functional use of Kazakh language in everyday life.





THEMATIC VOCABULARY MINIMUMS OF WORDS AND PHRASES

Thematic vocabulary minimums of words and phrases that is sufficient for each level was developed for learning Kazakh language. The vocabulary minimums were designed in accordance with the principles of international and European standards of language learning as well as taking into consideration social peculiarities of the country. English and Russian translations of words and phrases are also presented in the book. Lexical unites in elementary level – 800, in pre-intermediate level – 1783 units, in intermediate level – 2229, in upper intermediate level – 3954 units and in advanced level – 5060 units.

«TIL – KURAL» A METHODICAL AID OF PREPARING TO KAZTEST

«Til-kulral» is a methodical aid for preparing to the KAZTEST exams in five levels. Aids give test takers an opportunity to pass diagnostic testing, then analyzing the correct answers of these test items, thus forming language learning skills of the test takers. Appendixes, monologues and dialogues according to the pronunciation norms of speaking Kazakh are given in CD at the end of the aid. In first two levels Conception of test items, rules and main notes are given in Russian language.





METHODICAL AID FOR PREPARATION TO KAZTEST

Methodical aid for preparation to KAZTEST (Kazakh language knowledge assessment) exams is designed to a wide range of Kazakh language learners. Listening, Reading and Writing block tests and exercise tests which facilitate learning Kazakh language are analyzed in the aid. First two levels of KAZTEST exam preparation aid are translated into Russian.

TEXTBOOK FOR TEACHING KAZAKH LANGUAGE

Knowing grammar is not enough to be proficient in Kazakh. Complex methods of skills formation in language activities (Listening, Reading, Writing and Speaking) are needed. In this respect five leveled text-books of learning Kazakh could be effective. Updating the thematic materials of the textbook in moving from level to level turns the process of leaning Kazakh language encouraging.



EXERCISE TESTS



In the process of preparing to KAZTEST exams, it is helpful for language learners to train themselves via test item analysis. Exercise tests facilitate test-takers familiarization with KAZTEST items, comprehension of the test tasks and choice of correct answer. Each level of the book has two test forms of assessing Listening, Reading and Writing.

GRAMMAR-REFERENCE OF TEACHING KAZAKH

It is impossible to be proficient without grammar knowledge in Kazakh. Therefore, Grammar reference is the next component part of the methodical complex. In the process of forming grammar skills communicative competence foundations are formulated. In Applied Linguistics language activities (Listening, Reading, Writing and Speaking) are used to denote communicative competence. Grammar reference-book is an aid that teaches language learners to speak and write according to given situations in each level.



ELECTRONIC TEXT-BOOK OF GRAMMAR-REFERENCE



Also electronic version of the Grammar-reference is designed. The main aim of the reference book is to explain Kazakh language grammar in everyday use. Possibilities of performing interactive exercises are considered in the text-book with 93 lessons. Samples are given performing the exercises. The possibility of checking the answers are also taken into account. Language learners can choose any lesson that interests them and print materials. Elementary level of electronic teaching aid can be downloaded from the website www.kazakhtest.kz.

SOFTWARE OF COMPUTER TESTING

Computer testing consisting 150 test items shows learners Kazakh language knowledge level. After the test language learners can print hard copy of their results. An interface of the software is in Kazakh and Russian languages. Computer testing can be downloaded from the website www.kazakhtest.kz. In 2016 new forms computer testing consisting 50 test items are designed in order to administer among 10th grade students and candidates to public officials corpus of «B». http://kazakhtest.kz/download Computer testing for 10th grade students consists of 50 test items and 3 blocks: Listening - 15, Lexics-grammatical structure – 20, Reading – 15 test items. Computer testing for 10th grade students consists of 50 test items and 3 blocks: Listening – 15, Lexis-grammatical structure – 20, Reading – 15 test items. Computer testing for candidates to public officials of corpus «B» also consists of 50 test items and 3 blocks: Listening – 10, Lexis-grammatical structure – 20, Reading – 20 test items.






WEBSITE OF KAZTEST

REALIZING THE «KAZAKH LANGUAGE LEVEL ASSESSMENT (KAZTEST)»

State service «Kazakh language level assessment (KAZTEST)» is automatized with the expansion of «E-government» services frame. The aim of the service is to computerize the application process. This state service eases the process of applying to the test and informing the test date to the test-taker. In addition, test-takers can elicit information about receiving a certificate or a reference about their Kazakh language knowledge level.
